

Report on the European Breed Show of Pigeon Breeds from the Balkans.

This RBES was connected to the 46th National Small Animal Show in Sombor (Serbia) from 27 to 29 January. Total number of animals of all breeds 3,000. The city of Sombor is not unknown in the pigeon scene and is geographically relatively centrally located. The exhibition hall at the end of the town in an abandoned supermarket was ideal in terms of size and excellent lighting.



Opening on Friday with folklore group and politics

At this show there were just over 1,400 pigeons including racing pigeons, 516 of which were entered in the RBES. Unfortunately, also in Serbia the stricter EU regulations have prohibited the import of pigeons from other nations. The 516 pigeons in the RBES were divided among 30 breeds from three nations. The judging panel also consisted of 3 nations. The scoring was positively implemented with the EE judging system and the corresponding cards.
