

NATIONAL SHOW AT THE PIGEON-CLUB D'ILLKIRCH

European Championship and Coupe de France du MONDAIN

EXHIBITION REGULATIONS

Art. 1: The show organised by the Pigeon Club of Illkirch will take place from 3 to 5 February 2023 at the Hall du Pigeon-Club, rue Wolfley- Zone de Loisirs Girlenhirsch 67400 ILLKIRCH-GRAFFENSTADEN.

This European Championship is open to all Mondain breeders. The prizes and premiums of the Coupe de France are reserved for members of the Club des Amis du Mondain who have their entry up to date.

Art. 2: The entry fees are set as follow:

UNITS:	5.00 €
Catalogue, Winner list + fee (compulsory)	15.00 €
Gala evening	25.00 €

Art 3: Entry forms are to be sent tot he organiser manager.

Closing date: 20 December 2022 due to the management of the entry capacity.

Art. 4: Classification: The pigeons are divided into separate young and old classes. It is therefore mandatory to mention this on the entry forms. Age limit of ringed pigeons: 2017. Mixing will be carried out at the level of classification of the pigeons.

Abbreviations:

MA - 1.0 Old MJ - 1.0 Young, ringed 2022

FA - 0.1 Old FJ - 0.1 Young 2022

Pairs are not permitted.

Art. 6: Delivery. The pigeons must have arrived on Thursday at lasted.

Art. 7: Sanitary measures: The pigeons will be subjected to a health check on arrival. Any pigeon found to be suspect will be rejected, as will several pigeons in the same package, without refund of registration fees.

The animals must be vaccinated; please bring a vaccination certificate from a veterinarian or a veterinary prescription together with an affidavit from a witness who was present at the vaccination. These documents must be handed in when the animals are brought in.

Please note that breeders who do not have this certificate cannot install their animals.

Art. 8: The separate affidavit sheet, completed, must be returned to us with the registration confirmation as this will only be considered on this condition. The Illkirch Pigeon-Club will centralise everything to be sent to DDPP 67.

Foreign pigeons from the EU must be accompanied by a health certificate for intra-community trade (TRACE). The used vaccines must have a marketing authorisation (MA) in the country of the issuer.

Article 9: Responsibility

The organising committee will make all arrangements for the feed and supervision of the animals. The committee cannot be held responsible for deaths, thefts, mistakes or losses and damages of any kind that may occur to the exhibitors.

Art. 10: Each exhibitor must take care to affix to his package the numbers communicated to him by the Organising Committee. **When entering, each exhibitor must hand in B-sheets with the number of the rings in the identification** column. If these instructions are not observed, any complaint will be inadmissible.

Art. 11: Exhibitors wishing to sell animals are requested to indicate the selling price on their entry form. The stated selling price will be increased by 15 % for the benefit of the organising association and will be mentioned in the catalogue. Sold animals can be collected immediately by the buyer. Sales after the judging will take place within the availability time at the point of sale. The sale of animals within the show boundaries without going through the sales office is prohibited.

Art. 12:

No animal may be taken out of the cage without the presence of a supervisory commissioner of the show.

Art. 13: Honorary prizes and awards

Judging is based on points and is expressed as a numerical score only.

Honorary prizes and awards are administered by the Club des Amis du Mondain, which takes full responsibility.

Art. 14: Complaints of any kind whatsoever must be addressed in writing to the President within 15 days of the close of the exhibition at the latest.

Art. 15: In cases not provided for in these regulations, the decision rests with the President and the Show Committee. The latter may take all measures and decisions that serve the order and protection of the interests of the public, the exhibitor and the exhibition.
